

As the COVID-19 outbreak continues to impact our lives, the Marion Municipal Court is focused on making sure that the Court can continue to operate to administer justice and serve our community, while also ensuring the safety of our citizens while visiting the Court.

As the Court gradually reopens, we will be cleaning and disinfecting all surfaces in the Courtrooms, lobby, and clerk's offices routinely throughout the day.

All individuals who enter the Court will do the following:

- Undergo a brief screening, including a temperature check. Individuals exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 are not permitted to enter the Court.
- Have their hands sanitized.
- Be required to wear a face covering, unless not recommended for health purposes or if there is a practical reason a face covering cannot be worn.

Also, the Courtrooms, lobby, and clerk's office have been reconfigured to allow for adequate social distancing. Because of the occupancy limits created by social distancing, the Court will limit entrance to the Court to only necessary parties to a case or those with business before the Court.
